There is no requirement that the nominees live in Downtown Orlando, just that the majority of their professional work and community service benefit downtown.

Limit your essay to 500 words (about 1 printed page using 12pt font). Excessively long submissions may be returned for editing at the discretion of the judges. Please note that the information you provide is the only information used in the DOTY selection process – no letters of support, newspaper clippings, or other material will be used. It is up to you to help make your nominee "come alive."
